MASKS FOR STUDENTS IN GRADES 1 - 3

Based on updated directives from the Ministry of Education, students in Grades 1-3 will be required to wear masks inside at school. We believe this transition will be easy for our younger students, as the majority were already wearing masks inside in the fall. If you have concerns about your Grade 1-3 child wearing a mask inside, please contact Ms. Kostuch in the School Office.

Here are some reminders for all students:

- All staff will be wearing face masks
- Grades 1 8 students are required to wear masks
- Kindergarten students are strongly encouraged to wear masks
- Student masks must be secured with ties, ear loops or elastic
- Students will wear masks inside at all times, with the exception of eating, drinking or taking medications
- Students can take masks off when they are outdoors (e.g. recess, breaks, outside lessons) and are physically distanced
- Concerns about mask wearing should be directed to Ms. Kostuch in the School Office

VISITORS IN THE SCHOOL

To minimize contacts and maintain physical distance in the building, parent, guardian and visitor access to the building is restricted. As always, the front door will be locked, but communication with the office is possible through the buzzer system.
